University of La Verne, in partnership with IBS Americas, offers the opportunity to discuss forefront subjects related to one of the most dynamic environment in the business world.

These institutions offer Higher Education (undergraduate and graduate) students the opportunity to attend intensive courses in the United States. The classes take place in January and July every year and cover a variety of cutting edge topics, relevant to driven young professionals.



The programs are aimed at **undergraduate** students in Business Administration or students in other fields with an interest in understanding the foundations of International Business, while improving their English skills.

The objective is to add important knowledge of Business Administration to students training, offering the student an advanced view of contemporary topics on the chosen subject and an indispensable international experience.

Classes are taught entirely in English, with full-time classes and activities. For students with English difficulties, there is also the option of attending an English program - "Business English - First Lessons".

The program takes 3 weeks, full-time classes, Monday to Thursday, starting at 9 am. To ensure close contact between the professor and students, classes are composed of groups from 15 to 35 participants.

# A program tailored to your



Our program has been structured to take place between school semesters, which allows students to extend their expertise and participate in an international program without having to interrupt their ongoing studies. A certificate of completion is awarded to students based on their attendance and participation in classes.

There is no final examination, instead the students present seminars and weekly work-focused assignments. The goal is to structure an interactive and concrete program in which students become involved in the development of practical activities.



Program Content

#### STRATEGY & MARKETING - SM

Strategic Thinking; Strategic Planning; Marketing and market conquest. Company visits and Business cases. Business English.

#### FINANCE & ACCOUNTING – FA

Financial Environment; Global Finance; Global Accounting. Company visits and Business cases. Business English.

#### BUSINESS ENGLISH - FIRST LESSONS - BEFL

Basic structures of English for business contexts. Grammar and fluency. Company and organizational visits — no tutoring or translation.

**Background Readings:** the students will receive a set of articles to be read, 4 months' prior the program starts, enabling the best class preparation.

The group will visit a well-known local company or have lectures with local executives. These trips and lectures provide the opportunity to gain first-hand knowledge about the intricacies of American business settings.

- Documents for obtaining a visa to travel to the U.S; (if necessary);
- Suggestions for tours, sightseeing, shopping and visits during your free weekends.


Flight Tickets: costs vary depending on the country of origin.
